FDIC NAMES DERYL R. BOOTH ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR DBS IN ATLANTA

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the appointment of Deryl R. Booth as Assistant Regional Director for the Atlanta Region of the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS) effective June 18, 1989.

DBS Director Paul G. Fritts said: "Deryl's experience as a field and review examiner with the Division of Bank Supervision and as a supervisory liquidation specialist with the Division of Liquidation provides an excellent background for his important new role."

Mr. Booth, 43, a native of Homerville, Georgia, came to the FDIC in 1968 as a bank examiner trainee and was assigned to the Rome, Georgia, Field Office. From December 1968 through December 1970, he was on military leave serving in the U.S. Marine Corps.

In 1971 he returned to the FDIC and was assigned to the Atlanta, Georgia, Field Office. In 1985 he was promoted to review examiner in Atlanta. Later that year he was transferred to the Division of Liquidation as a supervisory liquidation specialist. He served in that capacity until June 1986 when he returned to DBS as a review examiner in Atlanta.

Mr. Booth holds a B.S. in banking and finance from the Valdosta State College, Valdosta, Georgia, and is a graduate of The Graduate School of Banking of the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin.

He is married to the former Sylvia Biteman of Sanford, Florida.
