DBS NAMES STEVE SCHOLZEN DEPUTY REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR SAN FRANCISCO REGION

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the promotion of Steven K. Scholzen to Deputy Regional Director for the San Francisco Region of the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS) effective July 16, 1989. Mr. Scholzen has served since August 1983 as Assistant Regional Director for DBS in the Kansas City Region.

DBS Director Paul G. Fritts said: "DBS senior management has great confidence in Mr. Scholzen's abilities and we are pleased to have him available to take on the responsibilities of his new position. He will add strength to the management of the San Francisco Regional Office."

Mr. Scholzen, 41, a native of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, came to the FDIC in August 1969 as a bank examiner trainee in the Madison, Wisconsin Region. He became a commissioned examiner in December 1974 and was promoted to review examiner in May 1977. He transferred to the Kansas City Region as a review examiner in January 1981. In August 1983 he was named Assistant Regional Director in Kansas City.

Mr. Scholzen received his B.S. degree in economics from the University of Wisconsin. He also is a graduate of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin.

He and his wife, the former Jeanne Evilsizor of Appleton, Wisconsin, have two children.
