TWO DIVISIONS AND SIX OFFICES DESIGNATE RTC SUPPORT PERSONNEL

Two divisions and six corporate offices of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation have designated personnel to head up units that will provide support services for the Resolution Trust Corporation (RTC).

The Legal Division has named Rex R. Veal Special Counsel for the RTC. As Special Counsel, Mr. Veal is in charge of overall coordination of the legal services provided to the RTC by the FDIC's Legal Division. He will serve a dual role as the Associate General Counsel in charge of the Regional Affairs (RTC) Section of the Financial Institution Operations and Liquidation Branch. Mr. Veal most recently served as Counsel (Liquidation) in the Regional Affairs Section of the Legal Division and previously was Senior Attorney (CFO) for the Knoxville Consolidated Office.

In the FDIC's Division of Accounting and Corporate Services (DACS), Gary B. Sarsfield has been named Assistant Director, Administration, RTC. Mr. Sarsfield has been Chief, Bank Financial Reporting Section, of DACS since 1987 and has been with the FDIC since 1975.
