HARRIS N. WINKLER NAMED ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR DBS IN DALLAS

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation has approved the appointment of Harris N. Winkler as Assistant Regional Director of the Dallas Region of the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS). Mr. Winkler's appointment is to a newly-established senior level position, which was created to help manage the increasing workload in the Dallas Region. He has been Field Office Supervisor for DBS in Denver since 1982.

DBS Director Paul G. Fritts said: "Since joining the Corporation, Harris Winkler has admirably served in various field capacities, including Field Office Supervisor in three different regions. Such a background well qualifies him for his new position in the sizeable and challenging Dallas Region."

Mr. Winkler, 52, a native of Indianapolis, Indiana, joined the FDIC as an assistant bank examiner in the Indianapolis Field Office. At the time of his appointment to the FDIC, he was executive vice-president and a member of the Board of Directors of The Bank of Mitchell, Mitchell, Indiana.

Mr. Winkler became a commissioned examiner in 1968 and in 1969 he moved to the Bloomington, Indiana, Field Office as Examiner-in-Charge. He was designated Field Office Supervisor in Salt Lake City in 1975 and transferred to Denver as Field Office Supervisor in 1982.

Mr. Winkler is a graduate of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin in Madison. He and his wife, Shirley, have two children and two grandchildren.
