LAWRENCE MORGAN NAMED DEPUTY REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR DIVISION OF BANK SUPERVISION IN DALLAS

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation has approved the appointment of Lawrence E. Morgan, Jr., as Deputy Regional Director for the Dallas Region of the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS). Mr. Morgan has served since April 1986 as Assistant Director of the Planning and Program Development Branch of DBS in Washington.

DBS Director Paul G. Fritts said: "Larry's extensive experience in bank supervision has prepared him well for his challenging new management assignment."

Mr. Morgan, 44, came to the FDIC as a bank examiner trainee in the Chicago Region and was assigned to the Litchfield, Illinois, Field Office. He became a commissioned examiner in 1972 and was named Field Office Supervisor in Chicago in 1978. He was promoted to Review Examiner in 1981 and moved to Atlanta as Chief Review Examiner in March 1982. In May of 1984 he was appointed Assistant Regional Director in Atlanta. He was selected for the FDIC's Executive Development Program in 1985.

Mr. Morgan, a native of Cairo, Illinois, holds a BS degree in marketing from Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, Illinois. He is a graduate of The Stonier Graduate School of Banking at Rutgers University where his thesis on compliance was selected for retention in the school's library. He and his wife, Gloria, have two children.
