ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR DBS IN ATLANTA

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the selection of Bobby R. Beaty as Assistant Regional Director for the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS) in Atlanta, Georgia. Mr. Beaty has served since August 1984 as Chief Review Examiner in the Atlanta Region.
