MICHAEL J. ZAMORSKI NAMED ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR DIVISION OF BANK SUPERVISION IN DALLAS

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the promotion of Michael J. Zamorski as Assistant Regional Director for the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS) in the Dallas Region effective July 21, 1986. Mr. Zamorski is an assistant to the Director of the Division of Accounting and Corporate Services.

DBS Director Robert V. Shumway said: "Mr. Zamorski has broad experience in bank examination and supervision in three FDIC regions. We are fortunate to have a person of his knowledge and ability to assume this challenging position."

Mr. Zamorski, 31, joined the FDIC in 1977 as an assistant bank examiner in the old Philadelphia Region. He became a commissioned bank examiner in 1981 and was reassigned to the Hollywood, Florida, field office of the Atlanta Region. He was promoted to review examiner in the Philadelphia Region in 1983 and was reassigned to the Kansas City Region in 1984 in the same capacity. He was one of four managers selected for the FDIC's Executive Selection and Development Program in November 1985, in which he was enrolled at the time of his latest promotion.

A native of Wayne, Pennsylvania, Mr. Zamorski is a graduate (cum laude) of Villanova University, Villanova, Pennsylvania, with a BS degree in economics, and of The Stonier Graduate School of Banking. He and his wife, Cindy, have three children.
