RICHARD D. JARVIS NAMED
ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR IN KANSAS CITY

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the appointment of Richard E. Jarvis as Assistant Regional Director for the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS) in Kansas City effective October 7, 1986. Mr. Jarvis has been a review examiner in the Kansas City Regional Office since January 1981.

DBS Director Paul G. Fritts said: "Richard is a strong, dedicated bank supervisor and is well qualified to assume additional managerial responsibilities."

Mr. Jarvis, 42, a native of Alma, Kansas, joined the FDIC as an examiner trainee in Kansas City in October 1967. He has spent his entire career in the St. Louis and Kansas City Regions. He became a commissioned examiner in November 1971 while assigned to the Emporia, Kansas, Field Office. In July 1975 he was transferred to Hannibal, Missouri, and promoted to Field Office Supervisor. In January 1981 he move to the Kansas City Regional Office as a review examiner.

Mr. Jarvis is a graduate of Fort Hays State University, Hays, Kansas, with a BS in business administration, and of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin. He and his wife, Sally, have two children.
