DANIEL L. DIONNE NAMED ASSISTANT
REGIONAL DIRECTOR IN FDIC'S NEW YORK REGION

The Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today announced the appointment of Daniel L. Dionne as Assistant Regional Director in the New York Region effective September 1, 1985. Mr. Dionne has served since February 1984 as the Assistant to the Director of the Division of Bank Supervision (DBS).

DBS Director Robert V. Shumway said: "Dan has been extremely helpful to me because of his knowledge of supervisory issues, his keen intellect, and his ability to deal effectively with people throughout the regulatory community."

Mr. Dionne, 37, a native of Beverly, Massachusetts, joined the Corporation in 1968 as a co-op student from Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts. After graduation he became a full-time employee, becoming a commissioned examiner in 1974.

Mr. Dionne left the New York Region in July 1979 for a Washington assignment as a review examiner in the Problem Bank Unit. In February 1984 he was named Assistant to the DBS Director, a post he held until his current promotion.

He is a graduate of The Stonier Graduate School of Banking at Rutgers University.
