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## FDIC MAKES PUBLIC APRIL 1994 ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS; PROVIDES LIST OF HEARINGS TO BE HELD IN JUNE

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today released a list of orders of administrative enforcement actions taken against banks and individuals in April of 1994. One administrative hearing is scheduled during June.

The FDIC processed a total of 31 final orders in April. These included one voluntary termination of insurance status, two cease-and-desist orders, one call report penalty, seven removal and prohibition orders, one prompt corrective action, 12 terminations of cease-and-desist orders, one order terminating supervisory prompt corrective action directive, one order withdrawing notice of intent to issue supervisory prompt corrective action directive, one order withdrawing notice of intent to issue prompt corrective action directive ordering dismissal, one order terminating termination of insurance proceeding, one order withdrawing section 8(a) proceeding and two adjudicated decisions.
