

## **Foreign Assets Control Act**

SUBJECT: Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons

Summary: The Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control has amended

several entries listed as Foreign Terrorist Organizations on its list of Specially

Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons.

On February 9, 2004, the Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) amended several Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO) entries on its list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons (SDNs). The list of edited entries is attached.

OFAC has asked that we distribute the information to all FDIC-supervised institutions so records can be checked for accounts that are required to be blocked.
