SUBJECT: Entities That May Be Conducting Banking Operations in the United States

Without Authorization

The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency has advised us that the following entity may be conducting banking business in the United States illegally or without authorization:

First Lenape Nation Bank Route 1, Box 174D Anadarko, OK 73005

Proposed transactions involving this entity should be viewed with extreme caution. Attached is a March 21, 1997, press release from the Oklahoma Banking Department alerting financial institutions and the general public about this matter.
