SUBJECT: Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons

On December 7, 2000, the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) amended its listing of specially designated nationals and blocked persons by adding eight new names of individuals and eight new entities to the list of Specially Designated Narcotics Traffickers.

Attached is information from OFAC containing all changes to the list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons since January 1, 2000. OFAC has asked that we distribute the update to all FDIC-regulated institutions so records can be checked for accounts that are required to be blocked.
