SUBJECT: Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons

Summary: Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control has amended its list of Specially

Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons.

On March 7, 2003, the Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) amended its list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons (SDNs), under the Western Balkans program, by adding two individuals and two business entities. See the attachment for a detailed list of the additional SDNs. OFAC has asked that we distribute the information to all FDIC-supervised institutions so records can be checked for accounts that are required to be blocked.
