SUBJECT: Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons

Summary: Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control has amended its list of Specially Designated

Nationals and Blocked Persons by adding names to its list of Specially Designated Global

Terrorists and amending several other names.

On August 21 and 25, 2003, the Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) amended its list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons (SDN) by adding several names to OFAC's listing of Specially Designated Global Terrorists (SDGT). New and revised listings are attached for your review.

OFAC has asked that we distribute the information to all FDIC-supervised institutions so records can be checked for accounts that are required to be blocked.
