


## **Changes in the Number of FDIC-Insured Institutions**



# Quarterly Change in the Number of FDIC-Insured Institutions 1996-2011










# **Quarterly Net Interest Margins, Annualized**








## **Percentage of Insured Institutions With Earnings Gains**










# Quarterly Return on Assets of Subchapter S Corporations vs. Other Banks, Annualized 2000-2011




# Noninterest Income as a Percentage of Net Operating Revenue\*







**Quarterly Cost of Funding Earning Assets** 




# Quarterly Return on Risk-Weighted Assets (RWA)\* and RWA to Total Assets




## **Loan Portfolio Composition by Asset Size**




# Utilization Rates of Loan Commitments\*




### **Real Estate Loan Growth Rates\***






# Risk-Weighted Assets as a Percentage of Total Assets 1991 - 2011








# Net Loans and Leases to Deposits (Domestic and Foreign)






# **Twelve-Month Growth Rates of Domestic Deposits**






# Quarterly Change in C&I Loans 2008-2011



















# Noncurrent Rates on Loans Secured by 1-4 Family Residential Properties 2008 to 2011












# Credit Quality of Residential Mortgage Loans\* 2008 to 2011




## Credit Card Loss Rates and Personal Bankruptcy Filings 1992-2011







### **Noninterest Income to Assets (YTD)**








### Industry Assets By Asset Size June 30, 2011 (\$ Billions)






### **Net Interest Margin (YTD)**


### **Noninterest Income to Assets (YTD)**


## Performance Ratios By Asset Size Noninterest Expense to Assets (YTD)





### **Noncurrent Assets Plus Other Real Estate Owned To Assets**




### Core Capital (Leverage) Ratio



### **Geographic Distribution of FDIC-Insured Institutions**






**Return on Assets (YTD, Annualized)**




## Performance Ratios By Geographic Region Noninterest Expense to Assets (YTD, Annualized)



### Core Capital (Leverage) Ratio





March 31, 2008 - June 30, 2011


#### Percent of Insured Deposits













# **Growth Rates of ARMs and Fixed-Rate Mortgages**




# Assets of Mutual and Stock Savings Institutions

2002 - 2011




