




Changes in the Number of FDIC-Insured Institutions










Quarterly Net Income 2010-2014






Percentage of Insured Institutions With Earnings Gains



Quarterly Return on Assets (ROA), Annualized




Quarterly Return on Equity (ROE), Annualized






Quarterly Return on Assets of Subchapter S Corporations vs. Other Banks, Annualized 2003-2014




Noninterest Income as a Percentage of Net Operating Revenue*


Trends in FDIC-Insured Institutions' Income & Expenses







Quarterly Cost of Funding Earning Assets




Quarterly Return on Risk-Weighted Assets (RWA)* and RWA to Total Assets












Loan Portfolio Composition by Asset Size




Utilization Rates of Loan Commitments* 2009-2014



Reserve Coverage Ratio*








Real Estate Assets as a Percent of Total Assets




Real Estate Loan Growth Rates*







Risk-Weighted Assets as a Percentage of Total Assets 1994 - 2014






Quarterly Change in Domestic Loans vs Domestic Deposits 2005 - 2014




Twelve-Month Growth Rates of Domestic Deposits








Quarterly Change in C&I Loans 2011-2014








Home Equity and Junior Lien Loans 2000 - 2014














Noncurrent Loan and Quarterly Net Charge-Off Rates 1994-2014



Noncurrent Rates on Loans Secured by 1-4 Family Residential Properties 2011 to 2014










Quarterly Net Charge-Off Rates on C & I Loans By Asset Size




Credit Quality of Residential Mortgage Loans* 2011 to 2014




Credit Card Loss Rates and Personal Bankruptcy Filings 1995-2014


















Industry Assets By Asset Size March 31, 2014 (\$ Billions)









Net Interest Margin (YTD)


Noninterest Income to Assets (YTD)






Performance Ratios By Asset Size Noninterest Expense to Assets (YTD)


Net Charge-Offs to Loans and Leases (YTD)


Condition Ratios By Asset SizeLoss Allowance To Loans and Leases




Core Capital (Leverage) Ratio





Geographic Distribution of FDIC-Insured Institutions





Noninterest Income to Assets (YTD, Annualized)




Performance Ratios By Geographic Region Noninterest Expense to Assets (YTD, Annualized)




Loss Allowance To Loans and Leases

Core Capital (Leverage) Ratio






Percent of Insured Deposits





Notional Amounts












Assets of Mutual and Stock Savings Institutions

2005 - 2014




