FDIC ANNOUNCES NEW ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF BOSTON DOS OFFICE

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation today has named Jimmy R. Loyless as Assistant Regional Director in the Division of Supervision's Boston, Massachusetts, Regional Office. His assignment was effective November 3, 1991.

Loyless' assignment is a new position, with primary responsibility for supervisory activities for institutions in Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont and Essex County, Massachusetts.

Before becoming Assistant Regional Director, Loyless served for two years as a review examiner in the Boston Regional Office. He has been with the FDIC for eleven years, including field examiner assignments in Georgia, Florida and Illinois. Loyless has served as an instructor at the FDIC Training Center, Regional Equal Employment Opportunity Counselor for the Boston Region, a participant in the Shared National Credit Review Program and a speaker for various banking and educational groups.

Loyless, a native of Bainbridge, Georgia, is a graduate of Auburn University and the Stonier Graduate School of Banking. He is married, has two children and lives in Holliston, Massachusetts.
