FDIC ISSUES FEBRUARY LIST OF BANKS EXAMINED FOR COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT

The FDIC today issued its monthly list of banks recently evaluated for compliance with the Community Reinvestment Act (CRA). Today's list covers the month of February 1991.

The CRA is a 1977 law intended to encourage insured banks and thrifts to meet local credit needs, including those of low- and moderate-income neighborhoods, consistent with safe and sound operations. In 1989, as part of the Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery, and Enforcement Act (FIRREA), Congress mandated the public disclosure of an evaluation and rating for each bank that undergoes a CRA examination on or after July 1, 1990. The FDIC on February 11, 1991, issued a list covering the period from July 1 through November 30, 1990. Lists covering December and January were issued earlier this year.
